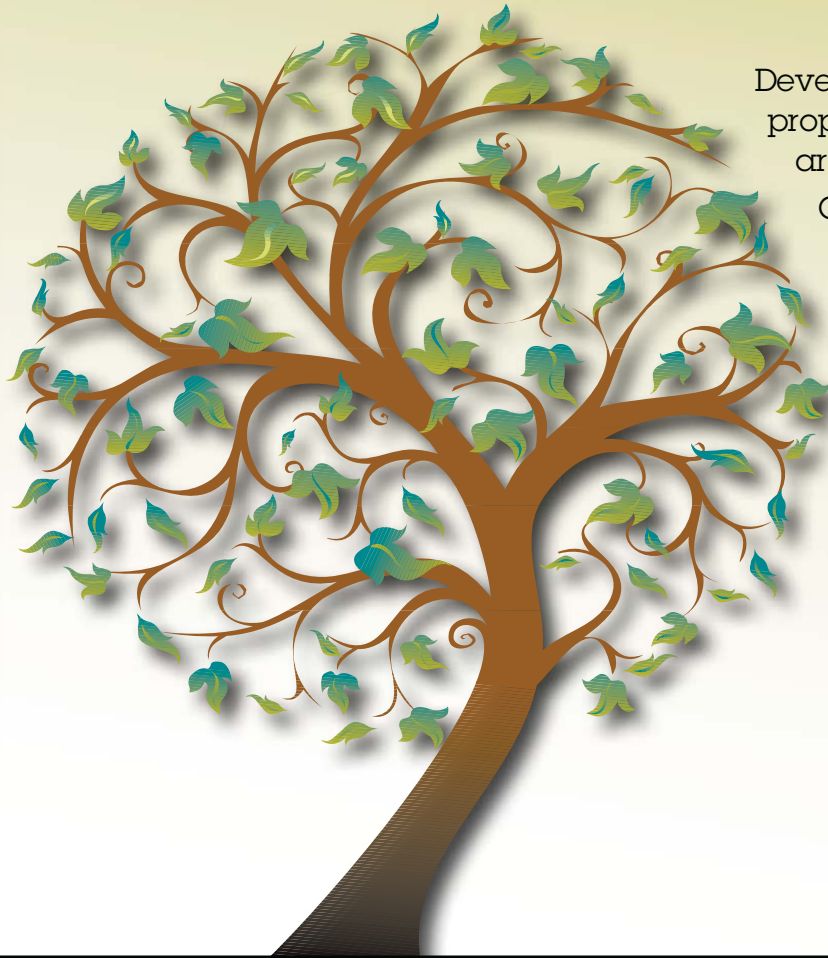


Living Green Starts at Home!

Enroll in the Free Homeowner Environmental Stewardship Planning course.



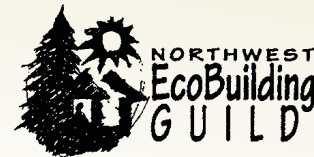
